

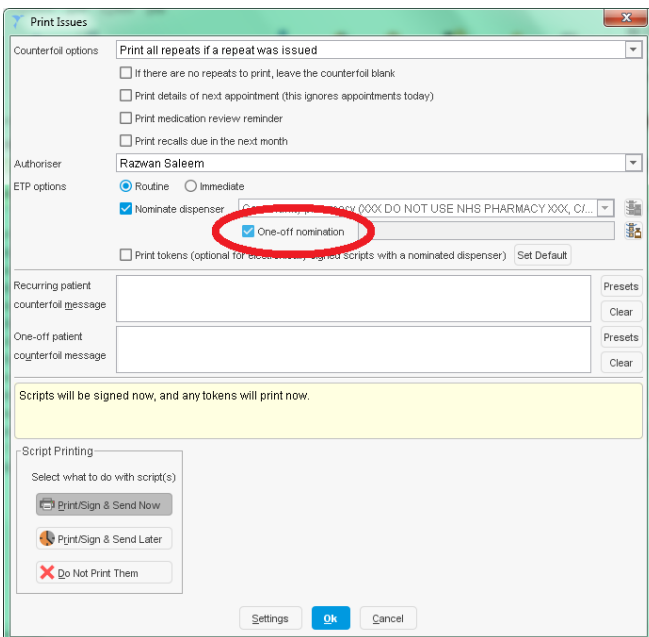
ONE-OFF EPS NOMINATION & NON-NOMINATED EPS TOKEN

ONE-OFF nomination functionality is available within S1 prescribing system. Use this to override the patient's regular nominated pharmacy for an individual prescription

Only use the 'One-Off nomination' if you would like to send a prescription to a different pharmacy than the patient's "regular" nominated pharmacy.
(do **NOT** change the "regular" nominated pharmacy)

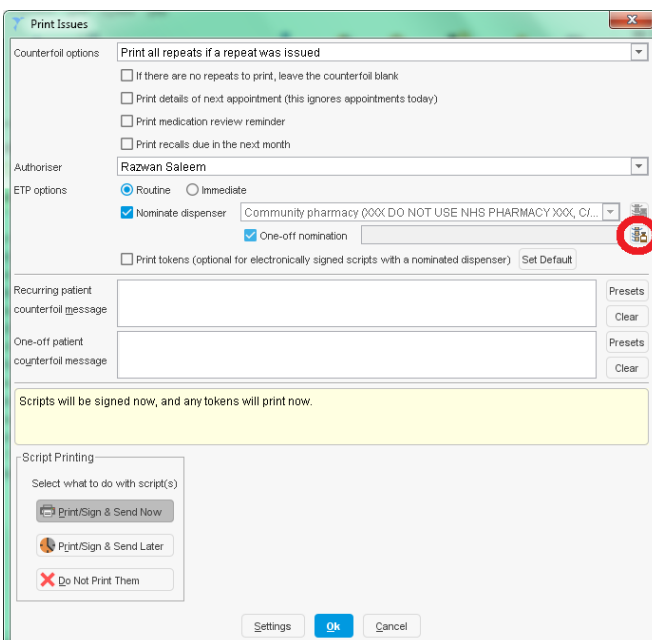
Tick the "One-Off nomination" box.

(This will not affect the existing nomination for "regular" prescriptions in the future)

The one-off nomination will not affect future prescriptions; they will continue to be sent to the patient's regular nominated dispenser, but the one-off prescription would be affected if the regular nomination is changed before it is collected.

Non-Nominated EPS Token: During a consultation it may be preferable to issue the prescription as a non-nominated EPS token, **so the patient can take it to ANY pharmacy of their choice**

Un-tick the "Nominate dispenser" box → click OK and proceed to sign digitally as normally. (*This will not affect the existing nomination for "regular" prescriptions in the future*)

Counterfoil options: Print all repeats if a repeat was issued

If there are no repeats to print, leave the counterfoil blank

Print details of next appointment (this ignores appointments today)

Print medication review reminder

Print recalls due in the next month
