Q) This medicine is priced above tariff but is still available what can I do?

A) There is a well-established process in place

O Ensure continuity of care for the patient

O Collect as much information as possible about the pricing from your suppliers

O Report this information on the [CPE website](#):

- Be as specific as possible about the product you are experiencing issues with, and the suppliers you have been in touch with
- The more reports and the more complete the information the CPE team have, the better. This forms a part of the evidence that CPE need when applying for adjusted prices and we are generally more successful where the evidence is overwhelming, though there are no guarantees

O After supplying the medicine, keep an eye on the [Price Concessions](#) so that you can make a judgement as to when you wish to submit the prescription so as to minimise or eliminate any potential loss made.

O Adjusted prices, if granted, apply for the whole month - so any prescriptions submitted for pricing at the end of the month will be paid at the adjusted price.
